# 90th Annual KC Golden Gloves Regional Championships April 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> 2024





## **FACT SHEET**

#### **Registration:**

Registration is open from February 19th to March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All boxers, coaches, and officials must register online with USA Boxing. Online registration link is

**Boxers must have annual physical uploaded to USA Boxing to register online**. If you need assistance uploading physical or registering online, please contact Desrae Richter at 816-260-5398.

Boxers must register online and have white passbook to compete. Coaches must register online and have red passbook to get wristband and participate. Officials must register online and have blue passbook to participate. Please contact Chris Walden chriswalden28@gmail.com with questions.

#### Divisions (There are three options for boxers):

- 1. **National Team Division** Male ages 18-40 and female ages 18-40. Minimum bout requirement of 10 bouts. These champions will receive a big belt and advance to the national tournament in Tulsa, OK in May of 2025.
- 2. **Apprentice Division** Male ages 18-40 and female ages 18-40. Maximum bout limit of 9 bouts. Boxer's age for both divisions is their age when they step in the ring. Champions will receive an award.
- 3. **Matched Bouts** All boxers aged 8-17 years old, male and female. Matched boxers could box every night. Each time a boxer wins he/she will receive an award. Matched bouts will be made according to Appendix F.

#### Schedule

Friday, March 28th – Deadline for all boxers, coaches, and officials to register online:

<u>Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>-Official Draw</u> The official draw will be held on Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM and can be viewed on FB Live. Matched bouts will be completed by Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

### Thursday, April 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday April 11<sup>th</sup> – Daily weigh in.

Weigh-ins: 4-5 pm. Physicals: 5-6pm Bell Time: 7pm

#### Saturday, April 12th - Daily weigh in.

Weigh-ins 9-10am Physicals: 5-6pm Bell Time: 7pm

BOXERS MUST WEIGH IN EACH DAY THEY BOX, AND ONLY IF THEY ARE BOXING.

#### Venue:

Memorial Hall, 600 N. 7<sup>th</sup> St. Traffic Way, Kansas City, KS 66101. All tournament activities take place at venue.

#### Weight Classes-For National Team Division and Apprentice Division only

Non-citizens are allowed to compete in all weight classes.

MALE: 110, 121, 132, 143, 154, 165, 176, 187, 198, 198+ FEMALE: 106, 112, 119, 125, 132, 143, 154, 165, 176, 176+

#### **Boxer Age Requirement:**

Boxers age 18 thru 40. All boxers must be at least 18 years of age on the first day of their local competition but not yet 41 on May 12, 2025, to compete.

#### **Age Determination Date is:**

To reiterate, when the boxer steps into the ring to box at the regional tournament, they must be at least 18 years of age. If the boxer is unopposed, they must be 18 years of age by May 12<sup>th</sup>, the first day of the National Golden Gloves competition.

#### **Golden Gloves National Championships**

National Team champions will advance to the Golden Gloves National Championships in Tulsa, OK from May 11<sup>th</sup> to May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025. KC Golden Gloves will cover all travel, meal, and lodging expenses for boxers, team coach and officials.

Weigh-ins – You only weigh-in the days you box and must box at the weight you registered at.

#### **No Show Loss Policy**

If a boxer is present and his/her opponent is a "no show" without at least 4 hours' notice to OIC, the boxer who attended will receive a "win" and the boxer who is not present will receive a "loss".

#### **Matched Bouts**

Matched bouts will be completed by Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Coaches Notes**

- Coaches will be issued a wristband. NO REGISTRATION, NO WRISTBAND. Registered coach or boxer competing will receive a wristband good for the entire tournament.
- For national team division, boxers must box at registration weight.
- Coaches are not allowed to view boxer registration list.
- Round times for all National Team Male and Female bouts will be 3 minutes.
- Cheek protectors are not allowed for the National Team divisions.
- The Men's and Women's National Team divisions are seeded based on prior year tournament performance and USAB national ranking.
- Round times for Apprentice Division will be 2 minutes.
- Matched bouts will be determined by Appendix F (24 months)
- Brackets & bout sheets will be posted online as soon as possible.
- Offical in Charge (OIC) will make final determination on all rules related concerns.
